You're saving lives, by God's grace, as more and more young people reach out to TheHopeLine in their moment of urgent need.

Here's a statistical snapshot of *how God used your generous giving* to impact the lives of students and young adults last year:

27,435 Life-changing conversations with Hope Coaches

42.5% increase in suicide interventions over the previous year (a total of 3,112 lives saved)

34.8% increase in answered conversations over the previous year

of contact attempts still missed for lack of funding for Hope Coaches (17,597 young people tried to reach us but couldn't get through)

27+% increase in decisions to accept Christ as Lord and Savior (nearly 1,600 souls)

A Hope Coach shares from the heart

"I can fully relate"

Tate has been involved in ministry his whole life, "running with the Gospel," as he puts it. "At heart, I'm just an evangelist."

The secret to his work as a Hope Coach? "100% reliance and dependence on the Holy Spirit," he says. "There is absolutely no way

that I, just in my natural mind, could come up with solutions and be able to meet people where they're at. It's just through an open hand and open ears to Him and how He's leading ... just being in that place of constant dependency on His voice. Even when I'm chatting with people on shift, I'm in prayer asking the Lord how He would move. I really treat it as ministry, which is what it is."

Tate can identify with many of the teens and young adults who reach him on TheHopeLine. He personally struggled with mental health. So, "I can fully relate and just put myself in their shoes, almost as if I'm seeing through their own lenses what it's like for them to be going through what they're going through. Sometimes I even share my story, which is: I personally got completely set free of oppressive anxiety and depressive thoughts — by the work of the Holy Spirit."

It's especially gratifying when a young person experiences a powerful turnaround during the conversation — "a complete 180 ... they've actually had a revelation of the Gospel and have had their eyes opened."

In one of Tate's first online conversations, the young person revealed a drug dependency. "I just shared with them how they didn't need that in their lives," he recalls, "and that they could be filled and satisfied with the love and presence of Jesus — and the chatter just got it, instantly, just got it and was completely, completely hooked on what they were made for, the love and power of God instead of a false substitute, a false comfort. They completely got breakthrough — like born again — gave their life to Jesus."

Tate's ultimate goal for the young people he connects with: "Leave them with lasting help — and the only true power to save really is the Gospel."

And he urges his fellow believers to give generously to TheHopeLine — "because every single chat and every single move that's made with TheHopeLine really bears eternal fruit, and it's a fruit that lasts. Invest in something that will actually bear fruit that lasts. TheHopeLine definitely does that!"

In their own words

My wife, Mari, and I decided to start giving to TheHopeLine in 2020 after I asked my uncle about places where he donates. He told us about TheHopeLine and its mission of taking kids from crisis to Christ.

After we had contributed for a couple of years, staff member Mark Gries sent me an email about the number of chats that had turned into conversions for Jesus Christ....

one person to Christ — and, if once in heaven, that person came up to me and said the giving Mari and I did to TheHopeLine was the reason they met Christ and are now in heaven, through His blood — every dollar spent was worth it.

My wife and I have taken investing in TheHopeLine and placed it into our final estate planning wishes, because who doesn't want more souls in heaven!

TheHopeLine does an incredible job of taking a mustard seed and converting it into a huge plant!

A flow of new fully trained Hope Coaches?

Imagine waves of dedicated young people arriving to be trained as Hope Coaches.

It could happen. We've launched a test partnership with YWAM (Youth With a Mission) that lets students in their "Front Lines" courses become short-term volunteer Hope Coach interns.

They'll go through the same training regimen as full-time Hope Coaches, and they'll be assigned regular shifts of service. Then, for 10 weeks or more, they'll minister to young people who reach out to TheHopeLine, which means many more hours of coverage — and far fewer chats missed simply for lack of available Hope Coaches.

If this test program succeeds, we'll expand the strategy to other YWAM courses, some as long as six months or more.

The needs of students and young adults in our world today are so great — demand is so high on TheHopeLine right now — we envision thousands of our Live Chat conversations being answered by these fully trained volunteer interns.

And those who catch the vision for this type of ministry, and who fulfill their calling with excellence, will be able to apply to become fully engaged Hope Coaches.

This strategy could create a steady stream of superb new Hope Coaches. And because YWAM's programs are global, we'll be building a culturally diverse 24/7 Hope Coach team across many time zones.
